## GUIDELINES FOR CORPORATE MEMBERSHIPS (2017)

Our Club allows corporations and other organizations to serve as corporate members. In addition to the criteria set forth in the Bylaws, the following guidelines shall govern corporate memberships. Each company may designate 5 individuals, one primary and 4 additional, to be part of the corporate membership.

1. **Initiation fee and dues.** The initiation fee for corporate members shall be \$250. Quarterly dues are \$200 plus two \$25 voluntary quarterly assessments for the local and international Rotary Club Foundations. One member is allowed to attend meeting covered by the dues. More members are welcome to attend but will be assessed a visitor's price to cover the cost of the meal. The attendance of everyone from the company will be applied to the executive member's attendance record.
2. **Changes to participating members.** If any of the participating members leave the Organization for any reason, the membership can be assigned to another participating member at no cost. The new participating member will have to submit an application and satisfy the general qualifications of membership.
3. **Conversion.** Any participating member may convert his or her status to an individual active membership for a one-time conversion fee of \$110 (plus ongoing dues thereafter) or apply for membership to another club subject to their bylaws.
